MSc Construction Management

Combining generic management education with construction-specific content, this one-year course provides civil engineers, architects and builders with the knowledge and skills needed for a successful career in construction management.

Course content

To gain the MSc qualification, students must complete ten modules and a major project of relevance to their career. Modules are assessed by written examination and/or coursework. Students who choose not to do the project will receive a Postgraduate Diploma on successful completion of all modules.

These modules have been designed to fit around the busy lives of professionals and include:

- Organisational behaviour and HRM
- Operations and information management
- Corporate governance
- Advanced practice of management
- Corporate social responsibility
- Leadership and management skills
- ICT for construction management
- International construction contracts and arbitration
- Project planning and management
- Project funding and finance

Employment opportunities

Graduates have an excellent opportunity to work with companies in the construction sector in UK, as well as in international organisations.

Entry requirements

The normal requirement is an honours degree (2:2 minimum) in civil engineering, architecture or a related subject. However, we are always ready to talk to potential students with other qualifications.

For those students whose first language is not English, the following qualifications are also required:

- IELTS: 6.5
- TOEFL (internet-based): 100.

Duration

Full time: one year, with the project taking approximately six months during or after this period.

Part time: two years, with the project taking approximately six months during or after this period.
